Activities have included important consolidation / conservation works on St Piran's Oratory, which was viewed by hundreds of people while it was being done. Many local people, and visitors from as far away as the United States of America, attended a guided walk to promote the work of the Trust, while hundreds again attended the annual St Piran's Day March.

## Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

The main achievement of the Trust during the period of this annual report was to carry out conservation work on the fabric of St Piran's Oratory, in order to ensure that the walls and their cappings were stable.

As the building is a Scheduled Monument within a Special Area of Conservation, the necessary consents were secured from Historic England and Natural England. The works were carried out by conservation specialists, under the supervision of archaeologists from the Cornwall Archaeological Unit, to the satisfaction of the statutory agencies.

In addition, trustees have raised the profile of St Piran's Oratory and the medieval church of St Piran through publicity in the local press and social media.

One guided walk was undertaken around the area to raise awareness of the history of the area, as well as an event to marks St Piran's Day on 5th March.

Trustees have also tidied up around the sites on a number of occasions and are continuing to raise funds towards the production of a comprehensive conservation management plan for the two sites for which the Trust is responsible. The Trust is particularly pleased to have recently received two pledges of funding towards these works.
