The funding from both Childen in Need and The Lottery came to an end on 31st March 2020. Fundraising for holiday clubs has been successful and has raised £8K from a variety of local funders. A BBC Children in Need application has been successful in raising £30K to support the Kirkley project for the next 3 years. The Covid 19 pandemic has made it impossible to deliver the project since mid March; we are monitoring the situation carefully and taking advice and will restart as soon as it is possible.
