FinCHE Community Group became a CIO in December 2017. Its role is to generate funds for the purchase of children's play area equipment for the youngsters of Cornish Hall End and Finchingfield villages in rural North Essex.

The desire from the villagers of both villages for a MUGA (Multi Use Games Area) lead to the formation of the charity Work began with the Parish Council towards this aim, but the new council elected in May 2019, had doubts and the Covid – 19 outbreak has caused the idea to be put on the back burner.

The search for suitable trustees has also been fruitless.

To promote for the benefit of the inhabitants of Finchingfield and Cornish Hall End, Essex and the surrounding area. The provision of facilities for recreation or other leisure time occupations of individuals who have need of such facilities by reason of their youth, age, infirmity, or disablement, financial hardship or social and economic circumstances, or for the public at large in the interest of said welfare and with the object of improving the conditions of the said inhabitants.

The main activities undertaken for the public benefit can be divided into fund raising activities, and activities funded by FinCHE.


The main fund raising activity is the Finchingfield 3 Legged Race. This event was run by FinCHE before it became a charity. It takes place in July on a Sunday. The event has taken the place of the Village Fete. Volunteers help the trustees to run the actual race and the numerous stalls around the Village Green. The day has become a well visited event and local businesses as well as the charity benefit. The number of competitors in the race have trebled over the last three years. There are also now sections for children and juniors.

The 3 legged race provides 80-90% of the funding for the charity, and as I have said is a major fun day for the village.

Following a request the local primary school FinCHE agreed to fund after school activities for football and tennis. The classes were well attended and ran for the Autumn term until Christmas. Plans to run activities for the Spring and Summer terms had to be abandoned because of the Covid-19 pandemic.
