The gardens were tidied up and are now looked after regularly by a garden maintenance company which is more reliable than the residents doing it. The residents do, however, grow a lot of vegetables which they all enjoy.

Unfortunately one of our trustees, Trevor Jones, stood down in November 2019 and it has been difficult to replace him in the current climate. We are in discussion with one resident and hope they will be able to join as a trustee when the lockdown rules ease.

We did enquire about installing bollards at the front of the cottages, as they are very near the road and vulnerable to passing vehicles. After discussions with the council and a visit it was deemed that it would not be allowed due to the danger to pedestrians.

2020 started off in the same way as 2019, but as we all know, with the Corona Virus ended in a very different way. For most of the year we have just been making sure that the residents are safe and hopefully they will be in the first group to be vaccinated.

We hope that 2021 will be a much better year for them.
