Structure, governance and management

Gallipoli Music Memorial 2015 is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) and was established with approval of the Charity Commission on 7th August 2014. The CIO is governed by a constitution.

Trustee appointments were made in August 2014 for a three-year term. Trustees may serve up to three consecutive terms before a break is enforced. The Trustees meet three times annually.

Annual Report 2019-2020

There was little expenditure during the year as Trustees had agreed to retain the 2018-2019 budget surplus for future projects designed to have substantial impact on the area of the charity's objectives, including the responsibility to support the maintenance and deployment of the materials and resources created during the Heritage Lottery programme.

A Gift Aid claim submitted to HMRC for donations over previous years resulted in a repayment of £1516.

Board members are most grateful to the Revd Canon Jonathan Triffitt and parishioners of St Peter and St Paul Church, Blandford Forum, for arranging for the textile banner *They are our sons as well* to be permanently exhibited in an excellent position in the church.

The Secretary completed *Quiet Lives in Leamington Spa*, the story of the Browne family's move to Leamington and the upbringing and short life of the composer Denis Browne. (This work is likely to be subsumed into a fuller narrative written jointly with Professor Robert Sells which will use family records and other sources to examine Browne's life, music and the events that followed his death.)

1. Accounting Policies

a) Basis of preparation

c) Expenses

Expenses are recognised in the period when they are incurred.

d) Restricted funds

These are grants received for specific purposes. Expenses incurred for these purposes are charged to the restricted fund.

3. Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax as all its income is charitable income applied for charitable purposes.
