During this period HSAM has sterilised and treated 418 street animals. The breakdown of this is as follows:

150 cats sterilised 168 kittens treated 80 adult cats treated 20 dogs treated

The main focus of the charity is sterilisation. By controlling the population, the charity has lessened suffering and the spread of disease. This in turn has encouraged a heathier population.

We have continued to see a marked improvement of health throughout the street animals' population.
