Background

This is the second year of the Church's existence as a registered charity since registered with the Charity Commission on the 9th of August 2018 as a CIO under the Charity Number: **1179480**.

The Church continues to operate from the Portobello Community Centre where it reaches out to many residents in the city of Wakefield with the good news of the gospel of Christ.

The church's activities remained the same until the Covid-19 global pandemic that set-in during the last quarter of this Annual Report.

Charity Activities and achievements

Activities carried out by the Strong Tower Christian Centre includes

- Normal Church service: Church services held as published to the members
 of the public until 15 March 2020 when the church had to close for safety
 reasons due to the outbreak of COVID-19. However, normal church services
 resumed online via Zoom.
- Project 60: This project takes place between August and November yearly.
 The Project 60 was designed to encourage active reading and then to deliver
 live presentation based on what has been read in the book. Free books were
 handed out to participants who were determined to finish reading the book
 and teach from what was learnt from the book.
- **Summer Family Day Outing**: The church organised family day outing in August where both young and old enjoyed sun with music at Pugneys Park
- Church Leaders Quarterly Prayer Meeting: The Leadership Team of the church teamed up with other church leaders in Wakefield in praying for both the spiritual and moral wellbeing of the city of Wakefield that would produce salvation of the lost:
- Annual Christmas party: The Strong Tower Christian Centre Annual
 Christmas party was held in December 2019 at the Portobello Community
 Centre. It commenced immediately after Church service. It is open to the
 members of the public who come to enjoy the gospel while partying.

Risk Management

Following the outbreak of the Covid-19 pandemic, the Trustees assessed the risks level to which the charity was exposed and decided that physical worship at the Portobello Community Centre be suspended from 15th March 2020 until satisfied that it is considered safe to return for worship.

Volunteers

The charity appreciates the dedication and commitment of volunteers and friends of the church who under the direction of the of the church leaders perform several tasks in order to assist in fulfilling its objectives.

Financial Review

In view of the fact that the inflow receipts to the charity was less than £10,000, the charity has prepared the receipts and payment account in compliance with the Charity Commission's governing document.

None of the Trustees are employed by the charity and the receipts and payments are administered as laid out in the constitution of the Strong Tower Christian Centre.

Funding

This year's funds were from receipts from voluntary donations, Tithe and Offerings of members and friends.
