TRUSTEES REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2020

The Trustees, who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of Companies Act 1985, present their report together with financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2020. The trustees have also adopted the provisions of the Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities' issued in March 2005.

Structure, Governance and Management

The organisation is a charitable company limited by guarantee, incorporated on 13 May 2003 and registered as a charity on 7 March 2006. The Company was established under a Memorandum of Association which established the objects and powers of the charitable company and is governed under its Articles of Association. In the event of the company being wound up, the members are required to contribute an amount not exceeding £1.

Organisational Structure

North London Partnership Consortium has a Management Committee of up to 8 members who meet bi-monthly and are responsible for the strategic direction and policy of the charity. At present, the Committee has 5 members from a variety of professional backgrounds relevant to the work of the charity.

Objectives and Activities

The main activities of the charitable company are to provide a consortium of Black Minority Ethnic led, voluntary and community organisations, in partnership with statutory authorities, offering a range of services to further the social and economic welfare of Black and Ethnic Communities, including refugees and asylum seekers living in Haringey and elsewhere in the UK in order to:

- 1. Promote the Minority Ethnic Voluntary Sector in Haringey and elsewhere in the UK for the benefit of the public.
- 2. Develop the capacity and skills of the members of the socially and economically disadvantaged minority ethnic
 - community, including refugees and asylum seekers, living in Haringey and elsewhere in UK in such a way that they
- are better able to identify and help meet their needs and to participate more fully in society.
- 3. Promote equality and diversity for the public in particular in Haringey and North London Boroughs.

Statement of Trustees Responsibilities

The Charities Act 1993 (the Act) requires the trustees to prepare a statement of accounts for each financial year which give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the charity at the end of the financial year and of the resources of the charity for the period.

In preparing those accounts, the trustees are expected to:

- select suitable accounting policies and apply them consistently;
- make judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent;
- state whether applicable accounting standards and statements of recommended practice have been followed, subject
- to any material departures disclosed and explained in the statement of accounts; and prepare the accounts on the

going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the charity will continue its operation.

The trustees are responsible for keeping proper accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time, the financial position of the charity and to enable them to ensure that the accounts comply with the regulation under S42 of the Charities Act 1993. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the charity and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of error, fraud and other irregularities.

The trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year (under section 43(2)of the Charities Act 1993 and that an independent examination is needed.
