### TREASURER'S REPORT FOR YEAR ENDED 31 AUGUST 2020

#### **Trustees**

The Charity has a constitution which outlines how the charity will operate. The constitution also ensures that the charity has a chair, vice chair, secretary and treasurer. Trustees are parents of children at the schools the charity raises money for.

#### Objectives for the year

The aim of the MHSA is to enable parents to become part of the school community and help support the school in any way that they can.

#### Fundraising events including sponsorship and matched funding

The year 2019-2020 has been a challenging year due to the pandemic, we were unable to carry out several of our usual events. The events we ran earlier in the year, however, were successful enabling us to raise nearly £16,000.

The Fundraising events for the year 2019-2020 have been:

- Fireworks have raised a net profit of £5299.59
- ❖ Winter Fair has raised a net profit of £ 5531.12
- School disco has raised a net profit of £ 992.90
- ❖ Cake sales, and one-off events such as uniform sales have raised £ 1775.50

#### **Sponsorship**

Martyn Gerard kindly gave us £2000 to sponsor the fireworks event and have given us £1515 for the advertising boards. Due to the pandemic we were not able to put up advertising boards in the spring, however Martyn Gerrard have kindly donated £1500 for the boards we would have had. MHSA has also received several great donations from parents.

We are always on the lookout for engaging volunteers who can help us to source new sponsorship or match funding. If you have any contacts or links please let us know.

As you may remember last year the MHSA donated £29,700, £14,000 each to Moss Hall Infants and Moss Hall Juniors and £1700 to Moss Hall Nursery School.

Events and sponsorship have brought to the MHSA account a total of £ 15,624.11

MHSA does have some reserves which we have taken the decision to donate to the three schools to help them during this time.

MHSA will donate £20, 564.80 to be shared between MHI, MHJ and MH Nursery Schools. The remaining balance will be kept to fund the next upcoming events.

The goal for the year is to try and support the school by raising much needed funds, in a way which complies with the restrictions the pandemic puts on us all.

It goes without saying that these results could never be achieved without the fantastic support of the School staff and the parents.

And a thank you to our Independent Financial Examiner Allan Jackson for his help especially over the last month.


