#### **Annual Financial Report**

In the 2019/20 financial year our organisation has continued to develop in capacity, with its delivery of charitable projects and its business development to support those projects.

We have continued our work in support of family carers and the people they care for with a range of practical and social interventions on offer to help them improve their lives. We continue to meet new families in need of assistance through our work at the Jean Bishop Integrated Care Centre and our partnerships with organisations including the Alzheimer's Society, the Stroke Association and Versus Arthritis.

The Caring for Carers project has now entered its third year of support from the National Lottery Community Fund. We have also continued to receive funding from the James Reckitt Charity which contributes to our general running costs. As always we thank our supporters for their contributions to our work and our development.

During the year of 2019 we moved out of our home of five years at George Street in the city centre when the lease came to an end. Our office is now situated in the Hull CVS building at 75 Beverley Road in Hull and our café operation continues at the Jean Bishop Integrated Care Centre along with many of our social interaction activities.

The café has developed well with increased revenue from over the counter sales, catering for events and meetings and our contract for patient provision at the Jean Bishop ICC.

Our financial year ends in March and this year it coincides with an unprecedented period of change for the entire world with the outbreak of COVID-19. We move forward into uncertain times with a positive outlook as we seek to help those in need of support in new ways during the lockdown of the country and the issues this circumstance brings to each and every one of us.
