The Trustees have regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit. This is the charity's first year and it started with no assets. No charitable disbursements were made during the year. The Trustees attracted modest donations and spent the year preparing its website, opening a bank account, registering with HMRC for Gift Aid and designing a logo. Policy Documents covering, Conflict of Interest, a register of interests, the role of the Chairman, the role of the Secretary, Trustee Recruitment and Induction Policy, Grant Making Policy and Fundraising Policy were written and approved. A Minor Protection Policy was also drafted.
