Principal activities

I am reporting this year for the extended period from December 2018 to 31st March 2020

The charity has set up an attractive website which is linked to a paypal account to accept donations.

The first full meeting of the trustees was held on 6th November 2019 and the procedures for the beneficiaries was agreed

The set up of the stationery, charity logo plans for printing these was agreed.

The charity raised funds through donations to the web site and sponsorship of a half marathon run by Rose in September

In January and February the charity was able to transfer money to Kenya to support the children's education.

Income was from donations and the marathon sponsorship.

Costs for education were £611.88

the bank charges were fees for the currency transfer £15 per transaction and £9.60 paypal fees.

Other expenditure was the set up and annual fee for the website and purchase of a computer for Rose.
