#### <u>Annual Report for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> May 2020</u>

The governing instrument of the Trust is the Trust Deed dated 2nd June 1969.

#### <u>Assets</u>

The Trust owns the properties known as Olgra and Olgra Bach in Abersoch, and Pendorlan in Nefyn.

#### <u>Aims</u>

The main purpose of the Trust is the proclamation and furtherance of the Christian Gospel in the United Kingdom and elsewhere.

The Trust seeks to fulfil this by specifically:-

- providing accommodation for Scripture Union mission teams at the Trust houses in Nefyn and Abersoch..
- maintaining these properties to a standard which allows the teams to reside there during the period of the missions.
- letting these properties, when they are not being used by the beach mission teams, particularly to those involved in Christian Gospel work.

The power of appointment of Trustees is vested in Scripture Union.

#### Activities during the year:

The Trust has met twice during the year in order to plan for the maintenance and use of the houses. Some refurbishment of Olgra was undertaken in March 2020.

The Trust's houses have been used by Scripture Union mission teams as bases for the Scripture Union Holiday Missions in Abersoch and Nefyn. These missions take place for two weeks during the month of August 2019. During the remaining part of the year the houses have been used by 44 other groups for houseparties and holidays. (14 in Pendorlan, 11 in Olgra, 13 in Olgra Bach, and 6 using both Olgra & Olgra Bach.)

#### The effects of Covid-19

In April and May 2020, 4 bookings for Olgra Bach, 2 for Olgra, and 3 for Pendorlan had to be cancelled. Nevertheless, the accounts show a small surplus for the year. The main effect of the net loss of revenue is likely to be some delay in further refurbishments of the houses.

#### Public benefit requirement

The Trust's activities have sought to benefit the public by providing suitable accommodation for those working on the Scripture Union mission teams. This is linked to the aims of the trust since the Scripture Union missions seek to share the Christian Gospel. The Scripture Union mission activities are open to all, so further benefiting the public, in particular young people.

The Trust does not charge the team for use of the properties therefore there is no restriction of access by fees charged.

When the Scripture Union mission teams do not use the houses they are used by church groups for short-term retreats, training and planning, and are otherwise available for rent by the public.

Trustees have had access to and have noted the public benefit requirement.
