2. Aims and Objectives

- A credit card is held in the name of the Charity.
- Should Haslingden Girls and Ladies FC no longer be viable and the accounts need to be wound up then any residual funds, after all creditors have been satisfied, shall be donated to a Club or organisation with similar aims and objectives.

Other positions may be elected from time to time to assist with the running of the club. Trustees are elected by the Committee.

5. Achievements and Performance

The Covid 19 pandemic has impacted on the club, causing football to stop completely for the last three months of the financial year. We maintained membership numbers during this period and have approximately 170 players registered.
