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REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MAY 2019

The trustees who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of the Companies Act 2006, present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 May 2019. OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

This financial year we have continued to raise money to complete and improve our clubhouse, play area and equipment. Security Gates and fencing have been fitted to the rear of the building, the play area has been extended with a soft play covering and new equipment has been purchased designed to meet the varying ages and needs of the children, including a large portable swimming pool which has proved to be a great benefit to many of the children.

Money was raised by organising and attending local sponsored events and by donations. The charity continues to benefit from the enormous support of the Moto GP both in donations and fundraising. We also continue to benefit from the many local supporters who have raised money on our behalf.

We have used our facilities to their full potential this year, opening for play sessions regularly, which bring the families together to socialise and share their anxieties, uncertainties and make new friends while the children play and develop in a safe environment. It has been rewarding to welcome several new families.

A great many outings and treats were arranged for families this year including days out, socials, Christmas Party, Halloween and Easter events. The Mums have benefited from reflexology treatments, coffee mornings and social get togethers.

As trustees, we now look forward to another year where we can support our families and welcome new ones with these special children and to continue to provide a safe, friendly haven for them to come and be themselves without discrimination while parents and carers can relax and feel part of the community.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Financial position

During the year the Charity enjoyed a surplus of £1,540.

Reserves policy

As at 31 May 2019 the free reserves of the Charity were £34,821 and the Trustees consider this to be a reasonable level of reserves to ensure that the Charity is able to maintain the facility and support to the children and their families.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charitable company, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machinery - 10% on cost

Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
