Activities 19/20

TAARC has successfully held various event through the year 19/20, this has truly showcased the diversity of our community needs, whilst ensuring TAARC as a charitable organisation can adapt and cater for the needs of the community.

Events activities:

- Black History Month This also incorporated Local Primary and Secondary schools engaging in interactive learning in the importance of Black History.
- Windrush This focused on well documents events of the past, of a generation traveling on the famous HMT Empire Windrush from the west Indies to making their home in the UK.
- Family Funday Annual summer family fun day event for the local community.
- Christmas Party- This included the West Indian, Nigerian and Ghanaian communities.
- Youth club This is an ongoing well established weekly activity open to young people 8 - 18. Within the 19/20 we have partnered with Elim church to jointly deliver this activity; this has enabled us to reach a wider audience of young people.
