2.1 Basis of Accounting

3 Accounting Policies **INCOMING RESOURCES**

Recognition of incoming resources

These are included in the these accounts when the charity becomes entitles to the resources; the trustees are virtually certain they will receive the resources; and the monetary value can be measured with sufficient reliability.

Incoming resources with related expenditure

Where incoming resources have related expenditure (as with fundraising or contract income) the incoming resources and related expenditure are reported gross.

Grants and donations

Grants and donations are only included in the accounts when the charity has unconditional entitlement to the resources.

EXPENDITURE AND LIABILITIES

Liability recognition

Liabilities are recognised as soon as the liability has been entered in the quick book records.

4 ASSETS

Stocks

These are valued at the lower of cost or market value.

Tangible assets and depreciation

Tangible assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at the following rate:

- Building improvements: 15% reducing balance basis
- Office equipment: 15% reducing balance basis
