<u>Zoom Servíces</u>

This year has thrown up tremendous challenges for the Ministry and the entire global Church as a result of the restrictions put in place due to the Covid 19 Pandemic. Churches for the first time in UK history were not allowed in Law to meet and fellowship either in worship services or prayers during periods of isolation.

The use of virtual and online services such as Zoom has been essential in maintaining some form of contact within the Ministry. Zoom has been very useful for our Ministry as we were able to maintain our Services, prayer meetings and even teaching, delivered by the Apostle from Jamaica initially. The Pastors have been able to have pastorals with the relevant members also. This has helped to keep spiritually, enriching the lives of our members as well as the members of our community who patched into some of our Services.

Zoom is by no means a preferred method of fellowship as nothing can replace physical meetings. There was the initial weariness as people had to learn to adapt to using Zoom, and to effectively participate. However, members have been ministered to, given prophetic words, prayed for and greatly encouraged and edified via Zoom. We have witnessed the move of the Holy Spirit in our meetings on Zoom.

Crucially, there has been the development of relationships and greater working together with the international covering Churches of our Ministry, via Zoom. We have had good participation in our Services by members of our covering Churches and also a sermon by one of the covering Pastors. The International Pastors meetings has become a common occurrence on Zoom bringing together our Pastors from 3 different continents of Europe (Headquarter Church), Asia (India) and Africa (Kenya).

In conclusion, Zoom has been very useful to us in these strange times. We have overcome the challenges and maintained spiritual growth in our Ministry throughout this year by the use of Zoom.

Vacation Bible Schools

The Vision is to teach all generations Kingdom of God principals and it continues to expand through Vacation Bible Schools held in London, Mombasa, Kenya and Chennai, India. Children and teens had opportunities to have fun learning and working together. The development of a new team of Leaders in Chennai supported the increase of children attending a week-long programme of lively activities in four different venues, even on roof tops. In London, Theme 'Loving God the Jesus Way' where children learnt their value and experienced new opportunities through fun and even making kites to fly outside on the common.

They danced, brought dramas and the older ones gave exhortations. We were able to introduce new teachers who have excelled in this work and the children n have really benefitted for this.

Discipleship In Action

Our annual teaching week away 5 - 9th August 2019 was held at De Vere, Beaumont Estate in Old Windsor. This year we had a separate children's programme on the theme 'Joseph'.

Adult theme was 'Spiritual Growth', where we were asked to take an honest look at ourselves in three big areas: Moral development, Intellectual development and Gift/capacity development. Workshops explored related themes and new teachers were introduced this year.

Purpose and Vision


The Ministry has a long standing history of uplifting and supporting young people. The Vision for Endeavour Ministries is to enhance the provision provided stemming from the great work already happening in (VBS) Vacation Bible School. Endeavour Ministries began in September 2019 as a weekly session. Endeavour means to try hard to do or achieve something. It is an attempt to achieve a goal, so the aim was for children to build and develop life-long skills.

The purpose of Endeavour Ministries is for children to be:-

- encouraged to have a go at something new
- equipped to attempt to achieve a goal
- supported to overcome things in their life

The leaders met for the very first time in September 2019 when the ethos and ways of working were established which included:

- Bringing the essence of VBS to Endeavour Ministries
- · Being alert and listening carefully to children's needs
- Being aware of their feelings
- Encouraging all children to take part and join in
- Building an atmosphere of trust
- Creating safe spaces to talk



- Listen carefully and giving children time to speak
- Children to feel loved
- · Giving opportunities to learn something new

The Programme

The Themes for Endeavour Ministries sessions were

- 1. 'Senses'
- 2. 'Values'.

Each theme lasted several weeks. There were various mental/physical games; activities including role play, scenarios, cooking, craft, poetry and teaching (chat back)– which was a time for discussion and reflection.

The children were provided with a wide range of experiences and learning opportunities to inspire them; to develop creativity and to help them to excel and try new things. An evening on 31st January 2020 where children brought a parent to work with them through several activities was excellent with much laughter and serious construction, a fruitful time together.
