Trust structure and management:

The Trust is a registered charity, number 1148684, and is constituted under a trust deed dated 20th July 2012. The Trust was established by an initial gift from the trustees in 2012 and was additionally funded by an expendable donation from the estate of Mrs Ann M Burton (SIPP) in 2013.

In 2018 a donation of £1 million was made by GHB Holdings Ltd. A further donation of £500,000 was received in 2020. Two of the directors of GHB Holdings Ltd are also the trustees of the AMB Charitable Trust.

The Trust does not usually fundraise and seeks to continue the charitable work desired by the trustees through the careful stewardship of its existing resources.

All trustees give of their time freely and no trustee renumeration was paid in the year.

Risk management:

The trustees have considered the major risks to which the charity is exposed and have reviewed those risks and established systems and procedures to manage those risks.

Charitable objectives as stated in the deeds:

The Trust is a grant making charity. The trustees shall hold the capital and income of the Trust Fund upon trust for such one or more charities or charitable institutions or for any other purposes in any part of the world as shall be exclusively charitable according to the law of England and in such shares and proportion as they shall think fit including the following:

- the advancement of medical research
- the advancement of education
- the maintenance, improvement or provision of public amenities or recreational facilities
- to promote and further community participation in healthy recreation
- to benefit people in areas of social and economic deprivation
- the relief of poverty and unemployment
- to support the preservation of buildings of historical or architectural importance
- to promote, foster and maintain an appreciation of the arts

Grant making policy:

The Trust's grant making policy is primarily to provide funds for charities and worthy causes in the Bridlington / East Yorkshire area. Other charities and worthy causes outside of this region this will be considered.

How our grant making programme delivered public benefit:

Yorkshire:

This year the Trust has donated to two Yorkshire charities:

- The Hinge Centre

£35,000

- (a Bridlington based charity offering support in a wide range of areas including benefit & welfare support, job club, independent living, community & resettlement support.)
- Kingfisher Café (a Bridlington based food bank)

£15,000

Funds were also donated to the University of Hull to support their efforts in the fight against Covid-19:

production of 25,000 visors for NHS & care workers

£50,000

- clinical simulation teaching equipment ISim

£10,000

The Trust has continued to fund the university tuition fees of 2 students each year from Headlands School, Bridlington, from unprivileged backgrounds for 3 years each. This year the bursaries paid totalled £52,600
