Achievements and performance Section D We continued to raise awareness of our existence and the services that Summary of the main we are willing to offer through social media channels to the dental achievements of the charity profession and homeless groups and by attending dental shows such as during the year the Dental Technology Showcase and the Scottish Dental show. These attendances were at no cost to ourselves. We also continued to try and raise funds and donations by speaking at events such as rotary club meetings, local church groups and again via social media. Our main achievements in this year were: Working closely with other UK dental charities to complement the 'dental pain clinics' they operate within the UK by offering the services of volunteer laboratories who have made dentures for their homeless/poor patients free of charge via a postal system. We sent over donated materials and equipment to the University of Puthisatra in Cambodia to set up and run a training facility for dental technicians and to provide, no to low cost dental work to the poorest communities within the Phnom Penh area and suburbs.
