Weston Planets main role is to improve the health and wellbeing of the population living in the Weston-Super-Mare area by providing education and training for GPs and other healthcare professionals who look after them. We have provided 10 educational afternoons including topics such as Adult safeguarding, child protection, gynae/women's health, neurology, basic life support. We formulate our learning needs with all members having a vote on their required learning needs for the upcoming vear.
