## CHAIRPERSON STATEMENT

Due to the Coronavirus Pandemic, The Committee Trustees have been unable to hold an Annual General Meeting person to person or virtually for the Bermuda Community Association. We had hoped the government guidelines restrictions would have been lifted to enable us to organize our A.G.M before the deadline date for year ending:- 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020. The annual accounts for this period have been audited and certified by our accountant on 20<sup>th</sup> September 2020.

The committee trustees have also viewed and approved these annual audited accounts.

We will however endeavor to organize and hold the A.G.M for the year 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020 as soon as possible after the government restrictions permit suitable social gatherings.

## SECRETARY'S REPORT

The L.I.F grant for refurbishment of the hall started in November 2018, and was due to last until March 2019. However that took longer than expected due to some unforeseen issues with the building work, and we were unable to return to the premises until June 2019.

We had already sourced temporary venues for all of our annual hall user groups to continue operating whilst the refurbishment was taking place.

We advertised in our local residents magazine that we were re-opening our newly refurbished facility in June 2019 and would welcome enquiries from residents regarding use and availability of the hall. We have also managed to get the council to replace the sign on the main road pointing towards the direction towards the hall.

The Pre-School were the first to return in June 2019 followed by the remainder of all the annual hire groups, The original Pre-School then decided that they would not be returning to the hall after the summer break due to operating issues. We had several interested parties wanting to replace the vacant slot left by the closing of our original Pre-School.

The Committee Trustees felt and agreed it was necessary to fulfil this slot with another Pre-School as our commitment to the local community needs. A new Pre-School group was interviewed and is now operating within the original Pre School day time slot, with Ofsted approval.

All our other remaining groups who were sourced out during the refurbishment, (Martial Arts, Keep Fit, Community Bingo, Yoga Classes, Dance Classes, Street Dance Classes and Youth Club). all returned after the refurbishment until the pandemic forced us to go into lockdown on 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020.

Our local Ward Councilors also use our facility on the first Saturday of the month to enable local residents to raise any issues they feel needs to be addressed within the community. But again due to the pandemic this has also had to be temporarily suspended until social distancing and safeguarding regulations are eased.

We look forward to welcoming back all our local community and groups, and organizing our 2020 A.G.M once the pandemic government guidelines are lifted.
