Elworth Methodist Church Annual report 2019 -2020

As with many other churches the year was different to any other we had experienced.

It began well in September 2019 with plans for the year ahead to include Sunday morning worship, afternoon tea services combined with family craft group activities which had been well received and even a Sunday morning service over breakfast as we worked towards new ways of welcoming the community in to worship.

The new church coffee lounge was being well used by the community with visits from residents of local care homes, people using the local railway station and families spending time in the local park. Opening times coincided with groups using the church so that they were able to come in for refreshments before or after their meeting giving us time to talk and respond to any requests for help. Good relationships were built up between church members and visitors.

Our work for charities continued with our monthly charity coffee mornings including Macmillan Nurses, Huntington's disease, Christies at Macclesfield and Help for heroes.

Our harvest service was in support of Chance, changing lives – a local charity supporting families or individuals suffering hardship.

With the arrival of the pandemic much of our work was put on hold.

As many of our church members were in the at risk group and following Government guidelines it was necessary to close the premises.

Special arrangements were put in place with members forming partnerships committing to keep in touch with each other by phone or email. Each group of people also had a pastoral visitor who would keep in touch.

A weekly newsletter was sent either by email or delivered by hand to all members and friends in the community.

Access to Zoom & Sound cloud worship services was made available and also printed service sheets

Younger members of our congregation made themselves ready and available to bring shopping for anyone living alone without family to help. Some set themselves the challenge of making PPE equipment.

The building may have been closed but the 'church' came out into the community and 2 or 3 friends met in the park when guidelines allowed.

Our worship,our prayer life our work for the community continued from our own homes always looking ahead to a time when as a church family we could return to the building.
