Christmas hampers for Young Carers: Food was collected from a supermarket, supplemented by spending £281.04 to make up 30 hampers.

Spectacles Recycling: 1047 pairs of spectacles were sent to Chichester Lions for processing and sending to third world countries.

Macular Society Support Group: The local support group was run by lions, with 11 meetings/outings organised during the year.

Message in a bottle: 60 bottles were issued in Burnley and 50 in Pendle.

Befriending: One old lady was taken on 3 outings before becoming too ill to participate.

Tree planting: Lions helped plant over 1,000 whips in November '19 in Burnley.

Healthy recreation: Lions helped out at the Hendon Brook race providing a water point and junction marshalling.

Youth development: No requests this year.

Peace poster: Three junior schools entered the Lions' competition. One participant won the District first prize.

Child Welfare: Hi-vis vests were provided for 2 more infants schools in early 2019. Some toys were purchased for a needy family with children.
