Section D Achievements and performance Throughout this year, we have seen the support we have given to Summary of the main breastfeeding mothers dramatically change in the way we provide our achievements of the charity services due to lockdown restrictions. during the year Online support has been our main base where Mothers can contact our charity and our volunteers, peer supporters and ILBCCs are about to provide help and advice through written messages as opposed to face to face consultations. We have also evolved this further by offering support through online platforms for example Microsoft teams weekly. We are able to observe feeding taking place to further our advice and support that our peer supporters and IBCLC provide to mothers. Since our online groups have commenced we have offered support to approximately 30 breastfeeding mothers who have written positive feedback about the support they have received. We are now starting to make some plans to reopen our face to face meetings, when lockdown restrictions begin to ease.
