A period of transition

Treverbyn Community Trust (TCT) registered as a CIO in November 2019 and the period of transferring staff and assets from Treverbyn Community Hall to TCT commenced.

All grants expected to continue beyond the end of TCH's financial year in June 2019 were transferred to TCT by the 31st October 2020.

The 1st November 2020 was the date agreed by trustees for all operational elements to be transferred to TCT.

However due to COVID and the restrictions of the furlough scheme continuing into the next financial year it was decided to continue staff employment through TCH so that they could remain on renumerated furlough if necessary.

The transfer of land owned by TCH has also been affected by COVID, with both the staffing levels at the Land Registry and COVID restrictions impacting on the speed of this process. This remains ongoing with a completion likely early 2021.

The operational work of TCT started on the 1st November, continuing to support the community through the COVID pandemic with crisis grants, food support and sign-posting, online activities and phone a friend circles.

The trustees are extremely grateful to the amazing team of staff and volunteers who are so committed to ensuring everyone in our community gets the help they need; the charitable work that we do would simply not be possible without them.
