### Structure, governance and management

The Association was fully constituted as a Charitable Association on the 15 February 1993 and the Trustees are appointed annually at the Annual General meeting in accordance with the Constitution.

#### **Objectives and Activities.**

The objects of the Association are :-

- (a) To promote the benefit of the inhabitants of the Bockings Elm and Rush Green Ward areas (herein after called the "the area of benefit") without distinction of sex, sexual orientation, race or of political, religious or other opinions, by associating together with said inhabitants and the local authorities, voluntary and other organisations in a common effort to advance education and to provide facilities in the interests of social welfare for recreation and leisure-time occupation with the object of improving the conditions of life for the said inhabitants;
- (b) To establish, or secure the establishment of, a community centre (hereinafter called "the centre") and to maintain and manage the same (whether alone or in co-operation with any local authority or other person or body) in furtherance of these objects. The Association shall be non-party in politics and non-sectarian in religion.

#### Review of the year

At the beginning of the year we continued to seek funding for new activities for both young and old. We were fortunate in obtaining funding from Active Essex for activities and equipment for people suffering from COPD and have an active group of elderly residents participating in exercises to promote fitness. We also were able to secure funding from Active Essex for holiday activities for young people which included meals for them which were provided by a nearby Nursery with catering facilities and who we are associated with. We were gradually getting some increased usage before the Pandemic hit us but it has been a slow process as social attitudes change to leisure usage. In March along with the rest of the country we were subjected to closure under the Covid-19 restrictions and this remained the case to the end of our financial year in September. We have received financial assistance in Covid-19 Grants and Furloughed our employee.

#### **UP-Date**

However we must report that in December 2020 we were subjected to an Arson Attack that has resulted in a fire that destroyed nearly 50% of the building and at present we do not know the plans of the District Council as owners of the building regarding the future.
