CHAIRMAN'S REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 JULY 2020

My thanks to all the trustees and committee members for their efforts in the last year and as we move into out 10th year of Charity for Kids it is great to see that the charity continues to #makeadifference to the community it serves.

REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 JULY 2020

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 July 2020. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

Charity for Kids' objectives are to promote and further the care and relief of children, who are still in full time education, who have a terminal illness or who are suffering from a life threatening medical condition and in particular by granting feasible wishes of such children.

To also relieve the needs of children with a severe disability or impairment or any disability that immobilises a child by providing such facilities, equipment and services that are over and above those which the local authorities provide.

The trustees confirm that they have referred to the guidance contained in the Charity Commission general guidance on public benefit when reviewing the Charity's aims and objectives.

Charity for Kids was set up by Paul Harris, Paul was stuck in a rut of drinking, smoking along with a poor diet, to get fit Paul entered the Hastings Half Marathon and decided to raise funds to make a difference to the lives of poorly children throughout the local community.

Volunteers

Charity for Kids continues to have 10 regular volunteers and actively encourage new members to join through fund raising events, our social media pages i.e. Facebook, Twitter and via our own website. We continue to encourage new members through our regular correspondence letters which go out to local businesses and supporters.

None of the volunteers or trustees receive a salary.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable activities

In the past 12 months Charity for Kids has continued to help a range of children in the Hastings & Rother area.

These have included children with conditions such as Cerebral Palsy, Autism, Global development delay and spinal muscular atrophy.

The charity has provided equipment such as specialist trikes, walking frames, sensory toys and equipment, specialist beds and specialist car seats. The charity has also considered technical equipment such as laptops if these assist with a child's specific needs.

The charity has received support from local fundraisers, namely JTP Photography and Battle Facemask makers, who have provided financial support throughout this difficult year. We are also grateful to Hastings Direct, Kileys Carpets and Port Designs for their continued support of the charity.

Charity for Kids decided to close its respite caravan in December 2019 as costs to keep it running were not balancing its use.

Fundraising activities

The committee arranges and takes part in a range of activities. We are also privileged to have a range of local people, companies, schools and community groups who arrange fundraising events that have served us well in the last twelve months.

During lockdown 2020 we have been fortunate that as applications have arrived that local businesses and people have been able to continue to support us.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Principal funding sources

The principal source of funding for the year has come from donations and fundraising activities totalling £34,324.

Reserves policy

It is the policy of the charity that unrestricted funds which have not been designated for a specific use should be used to assist in the running of the everyday activities, whilst those that have been designated or restricted by the donors are held for the purposes they are intended for.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 JULY 2020

1. STATUTORY INFORMATION

Charity for Kids is an unincorporated charity, registered in England & Wales. The charity's registered number and registered office address can be found in the Report of the Trustees.

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

In preparing the financial statements, the trustees are required to make an assessment of the ability of the charity to continue as a going concern. The trustees have prepared a cash flow forecast and budgets for the charity and against the backdrop of the COVID-19 Pandemic a "reverse stress" test has been applied to the forecasts, seeking to establish the level of liquidity headroom the charity is expected to have during the 12 month going concern period.

On the basis of these forecasts and the fact that the charity has substantial net current assets and net assets, the trustees are confident that the charity has adequate resources to continue in operational existence and to meet its liabilities as they fall due for the foreseeable future. As a result of the above, the trustees have concluded that it remains appropriate to adopt a going concern basis of preparation in these financial statements.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
