This is done by at least two-thirds majority resolution of all existing trustees and whenever a trustee is so appointed or removed a memorandum of this shall is prepared and signed and sealed by the person presiding at such meeting and attested by two signatories appointed and authorized so to act under the Article.

We would need further Funds to accommodate to meet the demand of Local worshipers as Mosque is not able to meet the demands. We are holding local fundraising events to collect more donations.
- Covid 19 Pandemic has hit us hard due to continuous closure of mosque and madrasa throughout the year 2020, due to no income Masjid committee has decided to relieve full time imam and replaced it with voluntary duties performed by Mohammad Ashraf Hansrot and other local imams.
