Report of the Trustees
for the Year Ended 31 August 2020

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 August 2020. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The charity works for the public benefit having as its objects the development and education of children and young people in particular by:

- (1) promoting their care and safety;
- (2) promoting their education and promoting parental involvement;
- (3) promoting their health and wellbeing;
- (4) providing services to support them and their families and carers;
- (5) providing services to individuals holding membership of the CIO; and
- (6) furthering the aims of the pre-school learning alliance.

Significant activities

The charity runs as a preschool, delivering care to children aged 2-5 years of age in the local community.

Achievements and performance

It has been a good year as we have strengthened the committee members to ensure we are in a good position with numbers. Our numbers of children has increased over the months which is all down to the hard working staff that Acorns has.

Public benefit

The trustees have paid due regard to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit in deciding what activities the charity should undertake. The trustees consider that they have acted in the public benefit.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Financial position

At 31 August 2020 the charity had total funds of £27,362.

Reserves policy

The Trustees aim to retain unrestricted reserves to three months of support costs in line with good practice and following the requirements of the Charities Commission. At 31 August 2020 the charity held free cash reserves of £26,184 which is in line with our policy. Restricted funds at 31 August 2020 were £1,178.

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) registered 15 December 2015.

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

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Acorns Preschool (Kington St Michael)

I report to the charity trustees on my examination of the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 August 2020 which comprise the receipts & payments accounts.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

As the charity's trustees you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011 ('the Act').

It is my responsibility to:

- examine the accounts under section 145 of the Charities Act,
- to follow the procedures laid down in the general Directions given by the Charity Commission (under section 145(5)(b) of the Charities Act, and
- to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of independent examiner's statement

My examination was carried out in accordance with general Directions given by the Charity Commission. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeking explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently no opinion is given as to whether the accounts present a 'true and fair' view and the report is limited to those matters set out in the statement below.

Independent examiner's statement

In connection with my examination, no material matters have come to my attention which gives me cause to believe that in, any material respect:

- the accounting records were not kept in accordance with section 130 of the Charities Act; or
- the accounts did not accord with the accounting records; or
