2. Structure, governance and management

The Fund was established under the terms of a Declaration of Trust dated 9 July 1997 with Charity Commission number 1065063. The Charity's principal address is Cressex Road, High Wycombe, Buckinghamshire, HP12 4PR. The Fund changed its name from Chepping View Primary School Fund to Chepping View Primary Academy Fund on April 1st 2012 then to Inspiring Futures Partnership Trust on 1st Aug 2018.

The trustees are appointed by the Executive Principal.

The day to day management of the trust's activities is delegated to the Executive Principal and his staff, none of whom receives any remuneration for their assistance in the running of the trusts affairs.

3. Objectives and Activities

The objects of the Trust are the advancement and education of the pupils of Chepping View Primary Academy and Abbey View Primary Academy providing or assisting in the provision of educational, recreational and other charitable facilities in augmentation of such facilities financed by the local authority.

In planning our activities for the year we kept in mind the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit at our trustee meetings.

4. Review of progress and achievements

The Trust had run some school trips prior to the pandemic, however the lockdown prevented other trips including residential. A number of school activities and various charities were still supported in the year where it was safe to do so.

5. Financial review and reserves policy

The cash reserves totalling £11,717 will be used to subsidise and support future activities.
