Para 1.20	In September 2019 Bodmin Preschool were subject to a full OFSTED inspection and achieved 'Good' under the brand new Early Years framework and were the first in Cornwall to be assessed. Other Preschools have since been assessed and only achieved 'Improvement required' or 'inadequate' outcomes with some leading to closures. Bodmin Preschool continues to provide quality childcare for 36 children at present aged between two and school age. All children benefit from either 2- or 3-year-old funding of 15 hours per week. We have 7 children claiming 30 hours funding. Despite the Covid-19 pandemic Bodmin Preschool have continued to provide high level support to children and parents.
