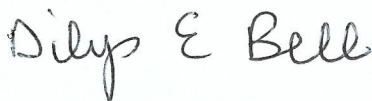

**INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF FIRST CHURCH
OF CHRIST, SCIENTIST, CROYDON (CHARITY NUMBER 238906)**

I report on the accounts of First Church of Christ, Scientist, Croydon for the year ending 31st October 2020, which are set out in the attached financial statements.

Respective Responsibilities of the Trustees and the Independent Examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The Charity Trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144(2) of the Charities Act 2011 (The 2011 Act) and that an independent examination is needed.

It is my responsibility:

- To examine the accounts under section 145 of the 2011 Act;
- To follow the procedure laid down in the General Directions given by the Charity Commission (under Section 145(5)(b) of the 2011 Act; and
- To state whether particular matters have come to my attention.


Basis of the Examiner's Report

My examination was carried out in accordance with the General Directions given by the Charity Commissioners. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeks explanations from the Trustees concerning such matters.
