The Trustees meet regularly to review policies, discuss ways in which the Chaplaincy can expand & have oversight of activities. There is a Team Leader to whom Chaplains can refer to for day to day issues. The Team Leader will escalate issues to Trustees for guidance/ to make aware, if required. The Chaplaincy is a member of Workplace Chaplaincy Mission (UK). Since the pandemic regular zoom meetings have been held which allow Team Leaders from across the country to discuss issues, share resources and opportunities and form working groups on new areas of collaboration. Chaplains have been able to join in training sessions via zoom across the country, and develop their skills and knowledge.
