Achievements and Performance

The Covid pandemic has caused a serious challenge this year and we have had to close our workshop for lengthy periods as determined by Government guidance. However, during those periods when we were allowed to open, we made the necessary adjustments to our workshop layout to create individual shielded workspaces. The number of spaces available was reduced to enable social distancing and enhanced health and safety procedures were also introduced. Additionally we arranged regular Zoom meetings to maintain contact with members, enabling them to share experiences and to discuss any concerns or worries.

Management meetings were also move to the Zoom platform.
