The Charity was incorporated as a CIO on 9 November 2017 to take forward the work of the unincorporated charity of the same name, Shepton Mallet United Charities, registered number 236426.

For the period of this report, from 9 November 2017 to 31 December 2018, all operations and activities remained with the unincorporated charity.

The objects of the CIO are for the public benefit:

- (1) the provision of social housing in the form of almshouse accommodation for the befit of older or disabled persons resident in Shepton Mallet and the surrounding area who are in need or experiencing hardship or distress;
- (2) such charitable purposes for the benefit of the residents in the almshouses if the CIO in such manner as the charity thinks fit from time to time.

The CIO remained dormant during the period from 9 November 2017 to 31 December 2018 with all activities undertaken by the unincorporated charity, registered number 236426.

However, due to unforeseen legal complications, the transfer of the assets was incomplete and did not actually take place. The charity is taking legal advice on possible routes forward. In the meantime all activities continue with the unincorporated charity (regn. no. 236426). The CIO has been dormant since incorporation.
