By way of our website, Facebook page, shops we have enabled the general public to access this service. We have paid for emergency vets bills where animals have been injured and we have taken in a number of animals after their owners have died or have become unable to care for them. We have re-homed these animals where possible, otherwise we are able to provide permanent sanctuary. We have worked closely with PAVO and social services. For many people their companion animal is their family and on a number of occasions this year we have been enabled people with mental health problems keep their pets in good health thus relieving their anxiety.
