The promotion of community participation in healthy recreational sport for the benefit of all children up to the ages of 18yrs by the provision of facilities and qualified coaches to develop children's football skills and provide for their involvement in league football.

Wyre Juniors is a Charter Standard Football club.

For the 2020-2021 season we have had approximately 190 children playing and training football over 15 football teams from the age of U7's to U16's. We have also run a Saturday Morning football club for our more junior members 4yrs -7 yrs. attracting weekly numbers of around 20 children.

Our footballing teams have been entered into either the Blackpool or Poulton District Football Leagues to play weekly football matches whilst at the same time our members attend weekly training sessions under the guidance of our coaches who are all qualified to a minimum FA level 1 standard. Training venues during spring and summer are generally held at our home pitches whilst all teams are located to indoor venues during the winter months.

The club ensures that all our managers, assistants, and any other adult who comes into contact with children are DBS checked.

All our coaching staff and committee members offer their services voluntarily.

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

The club has grown once again with the provision of football and training for approximately 190 children plus Saturday morning football/coaching for our junior members. We now also run separate coaching sessions specifically for our goalkeepers in conjunction with DC Goalkeeping which has proved extremely successful.

2020-2021 footballing season was certainly a very challenging year for us all with having to deal with Covid19. However, after following all the guidelines imposed, we still managed to train and play some quality football.

Our footballing teams were once again very competitive, and some teams won trophies whilst others gained promotions.

Our annual football club awards presentation had to be cancelled due to Covid however our individual teams had their own presentation as and when allowed.

We were successful in securing grant monies for the following projects from the Football Foundation:

- 1. New 11 aside goals at Pilling.
- 2. A pitch preparation fund for the maintenance of the pitches at Preesall Park.
- 3. A Covid Preparation fund to ensure our pavilion had all the necessary signage, barriers, and cleansing products for safe usage.

We are in the process of replacing all our existing plastic ageing goals with new quality aluminium folding goals.
