Principal Activities

The Objective of the Cultural Centre is to serve the local Muslim Community primarily as a place of worship and religious teachings. On a daily basis the building provides and facilitates worshipping facilities for local people to practice their religion in harmony in congregation or as individual.

Review of Business

Five evenings a week young children between the ages of 5 to 14 are to be taught the recitation of Holy Quran in Arabic and about their religious beliefs and practices in English. There are currently 70 to 80 children registered with cultural centre

The building is also used by teenagers and the elderly to hold talks about religious issues, and discussion sessions to exchange ideas about education, employment, training, sports and issues in general affecting their daily lives.

On a daily basis the building also acts as drop in centre for the elderly to meet their contemporaries and discuss their personal and social issues.

The Charity Continues to promote it main objectives in the coming years.

Respective Responsibilities Of the Management Committee And Examiner



1 Accounting Policies

The financial statement is prepared under the historical cost convention and include the result of the charity's operation which are described in the Trustees' Report and all of which are continuing

The accounts have prepared in accordance with the statement of Recommended Practice charity accounts.

The Charity has taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard No. 1 from the requirement to produce a cash flow statement on the grounds that it qualifies as a small charity.
