The CIO structure is set out in Standard Operating Procedures and published on the website. www.redcypher.com A steering committee of up to 8 Trustees evaluate approve/deny for charity proposals, initiatives and projects, particularly those using charity funds.

Red Cypher works alongside major military charities as required.

A full up to date risk register is maintained and managed by the Vice Chairman. Other policies are reviewed and updated annually. An Investment Policy was added in early 2021.

On 15/03/21 the CIO passed a Special Resolution to amend the Constitution to increase the maximum number of Trustees to 13. Relevant updates were uploaded to Charity Commission. At the same time the original manuscript Constitution was transposed into a more readable MSWord document, the veracity of which was checked by both Vice-Chairmen.
