DURING THE YEAR, THE CHARITY SECURED £20, 597 COMPARED TO THE PREVIOUS YEAR OF £10,491 IN DONATIONS AND GAVE GRANTS OF £23,755 COMPARED TO THE PREVIOUS YEAR OF £7,250. THE DEFICIT IN THE YEAR WAS OFFSET WITH THE SURPLUS FROM PREVIOUS YEAR AND AT THE END OF THE PERIOD THE CHARITY HAD £83 HELD AS RESERVES. THE POLICY OF THE TRUSTEES IS NOT TO HOLD ANY RESERVES BUT TO USE ANY SURPLUS FOR FUTURE CHARITABLE EXPENDITURE.
