REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES

The Trustees present their Report for the period ended 15 October 2021.

Aims and Legal Constitution

The objects of LFBM are the advancement of the arts and the education of the public for the public benefit, by promoting and advancing the appreciation and enjoyment of music of the Baroque era.

The CIO was formed midway through the 2014/2015 financial year. In 2014 when Lufthansa withdrew as lead sponsor (after 30 years as Lufthansa Festival of Baroque Music) LFBM was formed and operated with support from St John's, Smith Square (SJSS) in order to maintain operations until LFBM was set up properly as a CIO in February 2015.

The Trustees have referred to the guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing the charity's aims and objectives and in planning future activities.

The Financial Statements have been prepared on a Receipts and Payments basis and in accordance with Charity Commission guidance.

Trustees

The Trustees who have served during the period are as shown on page 1.

Review of Activities and Financial Report

In the summer of 2018, the St John's Smith Square Charitable Trust (SJSS) agreed to make the activities of the London Festival of Baroque Music (LFBM) a part of the core programme of St John's Smith Square. The previous trustees all stood down and were replaced by the then Chairman of St John's Smith Square along with two staff members. The LFBM activity was commissioned and resourced from then onwards from within the core SJSS charity and the intention was to wind-up separate LFBM charity. Unfortunately the formal winding-up of LFBM didn't take place at this point as planned and then the regular reporting of information was also not consistently maintained. The Festival continued to operate, but as an integral part of the SJSS programme of charitable activities.

In 2017/18 the charity organised a festival which took place from 11th to 19th May 2018 focusing on music of the French baroque and titled 'Treasures of the Grand Siècle'. The Festival welcomed a Guest curator, the French conductor Sébastien Daucé. 22 events took place over the 9 days.

St John's Smith Square provided all staff and office accommodation at no charge. From a banking perspective, much of both the income and expenditure went through the SJSS account, rather than the LFBM account, and has already been recognised in the SJSS P&L account.

The 2018/19 Festival, 'Crossing the Border' ran from 10th to 18th May 2019 and featured 14 events centred on the theme of migration. All transactions went through the SJSS accounts (the LFBM bank account was not used)

The 2019/20 Festival, like so much else, was cancelled due to the Covid-19 pandemic. There was therefore no income.

REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES

The charity has now closed its bank account, and has no assets or liabilities and is therefore in a position to be wound up.
