The prevention or relief of poverty, in particular (but not exclusively) among people in need who are, or formerly have been, inhabitants of, or employed or engaged in business in, the Parish of Coggeshall by; the provision of housing or accommodation; and such other charitable purposes for the benefit of residents of such housing and accommodation as the trustees decide.

Coggeshall Almshouses Charity (CAC) was created as the successor to the Coggeshall Amalgamated Charity and the Coggeshall Church Green Almshouses Trust. There are two groups of almshouses; both situated in Coggeshall: a terrace of six two-storey houses in Queen Street and four single-storey houses at Church Green in Church Street.

The main objectives in bringing these almshouses under the ownership of CAC are the combining of resources (for example, to ensure that we are better placed to fund the up-keep of the properties) and more efficient management.

During the period of this report the transfer of the remaining cash and investments held by Coggeshall Amalgamated Charity and Coggeshall Church Green Almshouses Trust to CAC was completed.

The programme of improvement to the Queen Street properties commenced in early December and despite the challenges presented by the Covid 19 pandemic, the trustees are satisfied with progress.

All the Church Green properties are in good order and are occupied.

The trustees have had regard to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit.
