Objectives and Activities

Our purpose is the advancement of the Christian faith generally.

We have considered the Charity Commission guidance on public benefit and specific guidance on charities for the advancement of religion.

We seek to share the gospel with others through services, outreach and practical help. During the week we hold:

- · Sunday services for Worship, prayer and Bible teaching.
- Tuesday Night Prayer Meetings
- Thursday Night Bible Studies

During the period covered by this report we had to stop physical meetings due to the lockdown regulations and move onto meeting using Zoom. We reopened once allowed to do so after carrying out a risk assessment.

Achievements and Performance

During the lockdown period we moved to online meetings. Whilst some were not able to utilise Zoom, we found a much greater interest in corporate prayer. We thank God for specific answers to prayer in individual lives during the period.

Financial Review

During 2020 the assets of the unincorporated charity (Milton Christian Fellowship) were transferred to Milton Christian Fellowship CIO once we had received consent from the Charity Commission. This took place on 31 March 2020.

Receipts for the 12-month period totalled £57,818, of which £42,505 was a legacy and £1,228 was interest received.

We have an ambition of giving a minimum of 10% of our income away to mission and other Christian work. During the period 26% was donated to missions and other Christian work.

Reserves

MCF aims to maintain free reserves at a level sufficient to cover up to twelve months' general expenditure, in order to give MCF time to respond to unexpected developments. At the end of the 12 months free reserves had increased largely due to the receipt of a large legacy of £42.5K during the period. If the effect of the legacy is excluded then free reserves decreased by £4.6K.

It is also our policy to hold an amount for likely building works required due to the condition of the building in the next 5-10 years. MCF has a low average excess of income over expenditure making significant expenditure of this nature difficult to cover.

As at 31 December 2020 free reserves stood at £157,534.

Structure, Governance and Management

Milton Christian Fellowship is a CIO and is governed by a constitution dated 10 Dec 2019. New Trustees are appointed by the existing Trustees in accordance with the Constitution.
