Trustees have had regard to the Guidance issued by the Charity Commission on Public Benefit. In order to achieve the Charity's objectives, initiatives have been designed to benefit all people in the community. Some of the activities that have been undertaken in the past year include the following: Weekly children's Sunday School which is open to the local community (suspended due to Covid.19 lockdown and restrictions). This is an essential part of our strategy for the advancement of education and the teaching of Christian principles. Being of assistance to the local Neighbourhood Watch whenever possible, thus creating the opportunity to engage with the local community. This has helped us to understand the issues in the area. We have assisted in developing a local community garden. Weekly meetings held for worship, bible study and prayer, all of which are open to the local community (suspended due to Covid.19 lockdown and restrictions – except Sunday Morning Worship which started back on 2nd August 2020).
