Para 1.20	 175 students sponsored through secondary and tertiary education Over 400 children mentored through Gender Clubs 3,500 Ufulu (washable menstrual hygiene pads) distributed to 700 girls who cannot afford them. This equates to up to 10 weeks of gained school, or 50 days per child Despite the pressures of the pandemic, continued to partner with Edulution to deliver 4 education centres focusing on significantly improving mathematics for 1,200 children. This saw an average improvement of 35% in maths results for children on the programme. 15 schools supported with hygiene supplies, gender support, and welfare programmes to tackle the worst effects of the pandemic. On top of hand wash and sanitisers we also provided: 7.5 tonnes of mealie meal (staple food) 1,500 litres of cooking oil Other necessities such as washing powder and salt Over 4,500 face masks
