The trustees therefore agreed to have plans drawn up by the Trust's architect to build two additional bungalows, to adjoin the existing ones, on a piece of spare land facing East Road.

Following a successful planning application four contractors were approached to tender for the work and PGR Construction, having submitted the lowest tender, was appointed as the successful contractor. Building work was begun in January 2021 and is planned to be completed by the end of July. The fabric of the old house is regularly inspected and repairs carried out as required.

Review of the year

Due to the Covid 19 pandemic, and government restrictions on meetings and social gatherings, the Christmas celebrations had to be abandoned and replaced by "virtual meetings. In order to replace the Christmas party the trustees arranged for each resident to receive a festive hamper which was very gratefully received by the ladies.

The Annual General meeting arranged for April 21st was cancelled and re-scheduled to 28th July when it was electronically conducted as a zoom meeting.

Due to the financial pressures being suffered by the retail sector, the trustees agreed to make a 50% reduction, for six months, in the rent of the Charity's one retail tenant in Oundle.

VE Day was celebrated by decorating the front of the old house with flags and banners and by the ladies holding a socially distanced tea party on the lawn. Mrs Mary Ormston gave a lovely talk about her experiences of the actual day in London. The ladies joined the other residents in North Street with the weekly clap in support of the NHS.

It became obvious that following a number of applications for the vacant flat in the old house that there was a real need to increase the number of available apartments. The trustees therefore agreed to have plans drawn up by the Trust's architect to build two additional bungalows, to adjoin the existing ones, on a piece of spare land facing East Road.

Following a successful planning application four contractors were approached to tender for the work and PGR Construction, having submitted the lowest tender, was appointed as the successful contractor. Building work was begun in January 2021 and is planned to be completed by the end of July. The fabric of the old house is regularly inspected and repairs carried out as required.
