Structure, Governance, and Management

Vision Temple of Praise is governed and constituted by a CIO foundation constitution

Trustees are appointed by Vision Temple of Praise by a resolution passed at a meeting of the charity trustees. In selecting individuals for appointment, the charity trustees are to take into consideration the skills, knowledge and experience needed for the effective administration of the charity.

The governance of Vision Temple of Praise rest with the Trustees and the Presiding Bishop who is responsible for the implementation of all policies and procedures and the regular review and control of the financial resources

Objectives and activities

The Church has referred to the guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing the aims and objectives and in planning the future activities. The main objectives of the charity are as follows:

- 1. To advance the Christian faith in accordance with the Statement of Beliefs.
- 2. To help relieve sickness through prayer and help relieve financial hardship and promote and preserve good health by the provision of short-term interest free loans, meals or services of any kind including through the provision of counselling and support.
- 3. To promote community facilities for educational, recreational, and other leisure time occupation in the interests of social welfare for persons who have need by reason of their youth, poverty, or social or economic circumstances with the idea of improving their lives.

In order to fulfil these objectives, the Church holds regular meetings where members and the wider public can attend in order to worship, pray, and obtain teaching on and participate in discussions about faith.

Achievements and performance

The charity has 2 other branches located in Tottenham & West Birmingham. We have started a children's ministry attracting over 25 children who are taught dance and music along with religious beliefs and teaching.

We continue to support the local community with food parcels from items donated by our members.

We continue to support people who have come to the Ministry with mental health issues by providing prayer, teaching, counselling, and friendship and offer telephone support.

We had a prayer breakfast which has attracted people from across the west midlands and the local community.

This year we have provided Christmas lunch for over 30 people from the local community for the elderly and those in need. We can say they enjoyed a three-course meal with an evening of music and games, they also received a small gift.

The Church continues to provide services for funerals, weddings, and christenings.

Plans for future periods

To continue its fund raising with the view to purchase a property. It is our intention to provide a breakfast club to help support local services users and the wider community at large.

To continue to provide our weekly Christian Education and Bible studies.

To provide transportation for those in need to enable and for those who wish to attend weekly services.

The charity aims to build and transition online with live services to advance the Christian faith in accordance with our statement of belief and to reach those unable to attend the weekly church services. To make Christmas party an annual event for the elderly and children in the local area and users of the charity.
