We cater for children with a wide range of special needs; social, emotional, behavioural and mental health issues.

COBS is committed to providing an alternatively structured and caring environment which offers progressive educational programmes for children who have struggled in conventional settings.

The 1100 Project was set up to assist with providing funding needed to address the social and emotional growth of our children in order to help them acquire the skills that are necessary to reintegrate back into schools/society.

In recent years COBS has worked more closely with the parents of its pupils by supporting the parents more directly with advice and educational workshops to enable them to nurture and develop their own children. This work is known as the Pathfinder Parental Engagement Programme,
