Para 1.20	The Covid pandemic restrictions during the year 2020-2021, have prevented the society from holding it's regular Wednesday evening meetings. The restrictions also prevented the Society from holding the Annual Model Railway Exhibition which is the most important way the society has of engagement with the wider public and model railway fraternity. This has had a significant impact on the Society's finances, as we have had to continue paying rent for clubrooms. Members have made some generous donations during the year. The Society has also been unable to hold Open Days at the Society clubrooms. The Society organised online meetings through Zoom enabling members to keep in touch with one another and share both their railway modelling interests and also how they were coping with the restrictions and difficulties that the Covid virus was causing in their and family/friends lives.

Zoom meetings have also enabled members to take part in meetings with other clubs, often geographically remote (for example Australia) leading to wider interchange of ideas and experience in railway modelling.	1
Many members have found the model railway hobby, that can be undertaken individually as well a in a group, has been a great benefit during the Covid 'lockdown' period.
